Preschool and Early Childhood Education

A good start for every child



The first years of a child's life are really important. Your child is growing and learning fast, learning lots about language and the world through play, whether alone or with other children. Often, that will go automatically but sometimes, a child needs some extra help. In such cases, the child health clinic will refer you to VVE (Preschool and early childhood education). This folder explains what that means.

What is Preschool and early childhood education?

The child health clinic (consultatiebureau) or your child's toddler group has indicated that your child needs more support in their development. That might be with language learning, playing together and/or motor skills. To give your child a good start at primary school in the future, your child will be allowed to take a VVE course at a toddler group.

Your toddler will attend the VVE toddler group for 16 hours a week, from the age of $2\frac{1}{2}$, where they will be coached in their development by professional educators. This intensive coaching will give your child the chance to move on to primary school when they are four years old.

Costs

VVE costs no more than regular toddler care. Your child is entitled to 16

8 hours of which you pay a personal contribution for. The municipality pays for the rest. The amount you pay for toddler care depends on:

- whether you are working, in a study programme or receiving benefits
- the amount of your income
- the costs of the toddler care organisation.

Toddler Monitor (Peutermonitor)

It's important to us that there are enough places available for VVE, so we use the Toddler Monitor to keep track. It contains the details of all toddlers who need extra support through VVE. An anonymous report shows Geertruidenberg Municipality how many children are receiving extra support and helps us improve the service. You give your consent to the child health clinic to share your details with the Toddler Monitor.
